Namma simple ask:

- 1. MLA must chair a monthly general meeting with parastatal agencies, corporators and citizen groups with set agenda to enable transparency and better co-ordination between agencies
- 2. Common website to connect and provide all relevant data and information about Mahalakshmi Layout
- 3. Transparent and consistent communication on current and future work. Public consultation through online and offline media.
- 4. Communicate legislator's stand on various policy matters that would be tabled in the assembly. Hold consultation with citizens on pressing issues via online and offline medium
- 5. Robust volunteering opportunities for citizens to participate for various causes.
- 6. Internship opportunities for college students and special opportunities for home-makers and senior citizens to contribute to Mahalakshmi Layout's development
- 7. Contact details of concerned officials (BBMP, BESCOM etc.) must be made available at ward office and other prominent places along with allotted time for grievance redressal.
- 8. Biometric attendance at all the parastatal agencies
- 9. Quarterly report to citizens on constituency's progress
- 10. Constituency map with CA sites and other amenities should be made available.

The top 5 ask:

Waste Management

- 1. Methodical waste collection system with separate vehicles for dry waste and wet waste. GPS Trackers are to be attached to the vehicle to introduce tracking capabilities
- 2. Scientific transfer points wherein waste from smaller vehicles is directly transferred to larger vehicle.
- 3. Visual cleanliness across Mahalakshmi Layout constituency must be priority. Few areas such as BGS compound, near Mahalakshmi layout swimming pool have large black spots.
- 4. The processing plant at Mahalakshmi Layout must be made functioning and more number of similar plants must be planned The processing plant located at Mahalakshmi Layout is to be running at full functionality. Along with the current plant, similar plants must be planned
- 5. Health care of Pourakarkmikas must be prioritized. A system that ensures an allotted number of Pourakarkmikas work at the ward level needs to be developed

Mobility and infrastructure

- 1. Communicate information on specifications of roadworks undertaken at Mahalakshmi layout
- 2. Only scientific speed breakers across the Mahalakshmi Layout constituency
- 3. Accessible public transport and last mile connectivity options from Metro stations Easily accessible public transport along with a last mile connectivity option from Metro stations
- 4. Reduce high traffic junction areas on Outer Ring Road.
- 5. Mahalakshmi Layout needs more number of playground for children. Lack in number of playgrounds available for children in Mahalakshmi Layout

Water

- 1. Two people lost their lives due to heavy rains in Mahalakshmi Layout. Mahalakshmi Layout requires an urban flooding disaster management plan and a dedicated implementation team. Measures should be taken to prevent urban flooding.
- 2. To raise awareness on water conservation, a campaign should be held and a kiosk must be made available to get easy access to water aerators and rain water harvesting experts
- 3. Since Mahalakshmi Layout constituency has just one lake, Rain water harvesting projects must be prioritized. RWH must be implemented on all public spaces and public buildings.
- 4. Periodic desilting and maintenance of storm water drains and sewage lines
- 5. Waste water from the Ashokpura Industrial Area has been coming into contact with the drain water at Mahalakshmi Layout bus stop. This has resulted in foam and foul smell. Preventive measures are to be taken to inspect the illegal discharge of industrial waste water.

Women and child safety

- 1. Public places must be well lit, have accessible footpath, sufficient police patrolling and CCTVs to aid redressal measures and specially to prevent cases such as chain snatching.
- 2. Special programs for young college students to help build their career building opportunities.
- 3. A larger number of Police Chowkis and aggressive police need to be patrolling across Mahalakshmi layout.
- 4. A dedicated counselling centre at Mahalakshmi Layout to help distressed women and children.
- 5. Anganawadis must be modernized, utilize better infrastructure, nutrition and early learning measures.

Environment and health

- 1. Mahalakshmi Layout has good number of parks and are well maintained. however, one of the said parks must be converted to an urban forest
- 2. Monitor and maintain green cover (scientific tree pruning) and open spaces in Mahalakshmi Layout.
- 3. Preventive health care measures to be prioritized
- 4. 24*7 emergency centres and Primary Health Care Centres
- 5. Accessible toilets in public spaces and parks Easily accessible and clean public spaces and public toilets
