Introduction



- BBMP General Election process is deeply flawed, the last date for withdrawal was on Aug 13
- Polling on Aug 22 giving only 6 day for campaigning which is too short for any meaningful elections
- A minimum of 15 days should be given to enable citizens & Civic groups to properly evaluate candidates
- The Electoral rolls too is deeply flawed with
 - Non inclusion of more than 5 lakh (as of today) first time voters by SEC for BBMP Elections which are approved by CEO KA & included in the CEO KA database
 - → 45,000 voters (as of 26th July) which was deleted in CEO KA database are not deleted in SEC database as reported by Cdr. PG Bhat, India's National electoral expert
- Due to this flawed process, B.PAC could only evaluate candidates from 81 wards

Selection Process



Wards

 Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP) spread across 198 wards in 8 Zones

- Predominantly Educated middle class voters
- Selected 81 Wards spread across all 8 Zones

• 1151 contesting candidates in 198 wards

More than 350 candidates in 81 wards

B.PAC's Endorsement Criteria



Evaluation criteria

1. Elimination Criteria:

- Serious criminal record
- ii. History of violence/abuse (whether convicted in a court of law or not) against women or children
- iii. Record of misuse of any public office for private gain
- iv. Shadow contestant (relative of sitting corporators, senior political leaders) where candidate is not socially or politically active in the ward
- v. Serious Negative feedback from socially active opinion makers & RWA's in the ward

2. Selection Criteria:

- i. Visible engagement in public service
- ii. Recognition in the community for leadership of civic issues
- iii. Demonstrated capability to improve the Ward
- iv. Accessibility to Public
- v. No conflict of interest between Public office and Private interest
- vi. Educational qualification and youth has an added weightage



Candidate selection



- Total of 380 candidates in 81 Wards in all 8 BBMP Zones were evaluated
- 50 candidates were selected after 2 step process
- 23 Female & 27 Male candidates
