Women's safety is imperative to make strides towards women's empowerment. B.SAFE Constituency is a unique initiative to bring different stakeholders, community and domain experts on a common platform and facilitate a safer assembly constituency for women and children through an integrated set of programs like public place audits , community awareness, recommended action plans and sustained advocacy.

B.SAFE Constituency program was envisaged as a proof of concept through implementation of the program in two Assembly Constituencies, viz Mahadevapura and Malleshwaram in the year 2020-22 and the program was continued in phase 2 and was envisaged in Hebbal and Dasarahalli in the year 2022-23.

This report covers the findings in Dasarahalli Assembly Constituency, with the ward delimitation boundaries as per year 2022 covering 12 municipal wards.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW



Every community has a band of committed leaders driven by passion and intention to help disadvantaged women but lack knowledge and necessary tools. This program strives to identify such potential leaders, and build their capacity to become 'B.SAFE Ambassadors'.

These community leaders will be empowered with intensive training by experts and they will have access to resources such as police officials, counselling centers, legal support, knowledge of schemes and loans offered by Government and other entities which are required for their onward outreach to the Community on issues of safety and empowerment of women in their neighborhood. B.SAFE Constituency program which is implemented by ward in the Constituency is led by a band of B.SAFE Ambassadors.

The audit findings would provide insights on how to improve safety and empowerment of women across 6 categories of public places and 10 streets.

The recommendations would be presented to key stakeholders viz; local MLA, BBMP, BESCO, BMT, etc

B. B.SAFE Community Awareness Program



An initiative to build awareness amongst women of the local community on personal safety and economic empowerment.

The initiative helps bring a sense of community amongst women and amplifies the voices of B. SAFE Ambassadors to meet their goal of making their constituency safer and provide support for economic empowerment.

C. B.SAFE College Awareness Program



An initiative to sensitise college students on gender related issues. The gender sensitisation workshop helps examine student's personal attitudes and equips them with critical thinking tools.

The goal of the program is to make students unlearn sexism, understand patriarchy, be active bystanders and learn essential law and resources to make their college and neighbourhood safer for all.

D. B.SAFE Nirbhaya Chalaka Awareness Program



The drivers of public transport are the eyes on the street with power to be active bystanders and make our public places safer and inclusive for all. They are the true representatives of any city and often first responders during harassment or violence in public places.

The B.SAFE Nirbhaya Chalaka is an initiative to sensitise the auto and cab drivers on challenges faced by women commuters and emphasise the pivotal role the drivers play in making public places safer for women. B.PAC has completed multi year gender sensitisation program with BMTC for its drivers and conductors, the number close to 27,000.

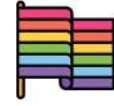

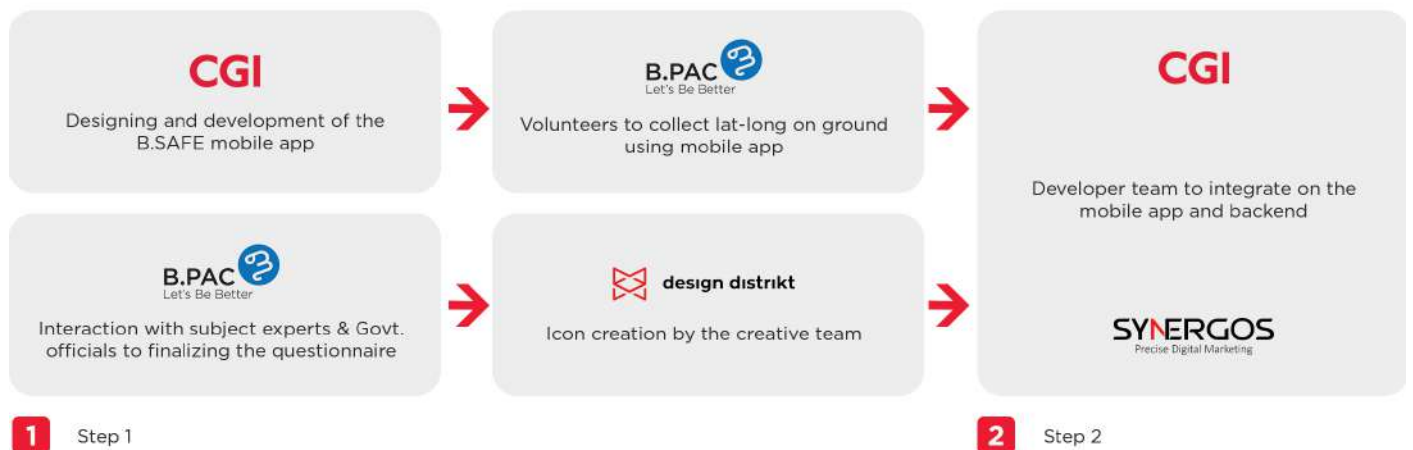

Post the session on capacity building sessions, Ambassadors along with volunteers were divided into groups to conduct the safety audits. Below image depicts the stages involved during the creation of the mobile app and also the safety audit process.





The detailed analysis was carried out on raw data collected from the above mentioned process. During the analysis, the raw data was sorted under must have and good to have categories. Further the scoring was classified under 5 colours, red being the lowest and green being highest. Constructed on the analysis performance of each ward, ward wise comparison and ward level scoring was determined.

This safety audit report is limited to the areas and facilities specified in the list of annexure 2. It does not encompass other areas or locations that were not audited. The audit was conducted during the period from June 2023 to July 2023. Conditions may change over time, and this report may not reflect the current safety status of the audited locations.

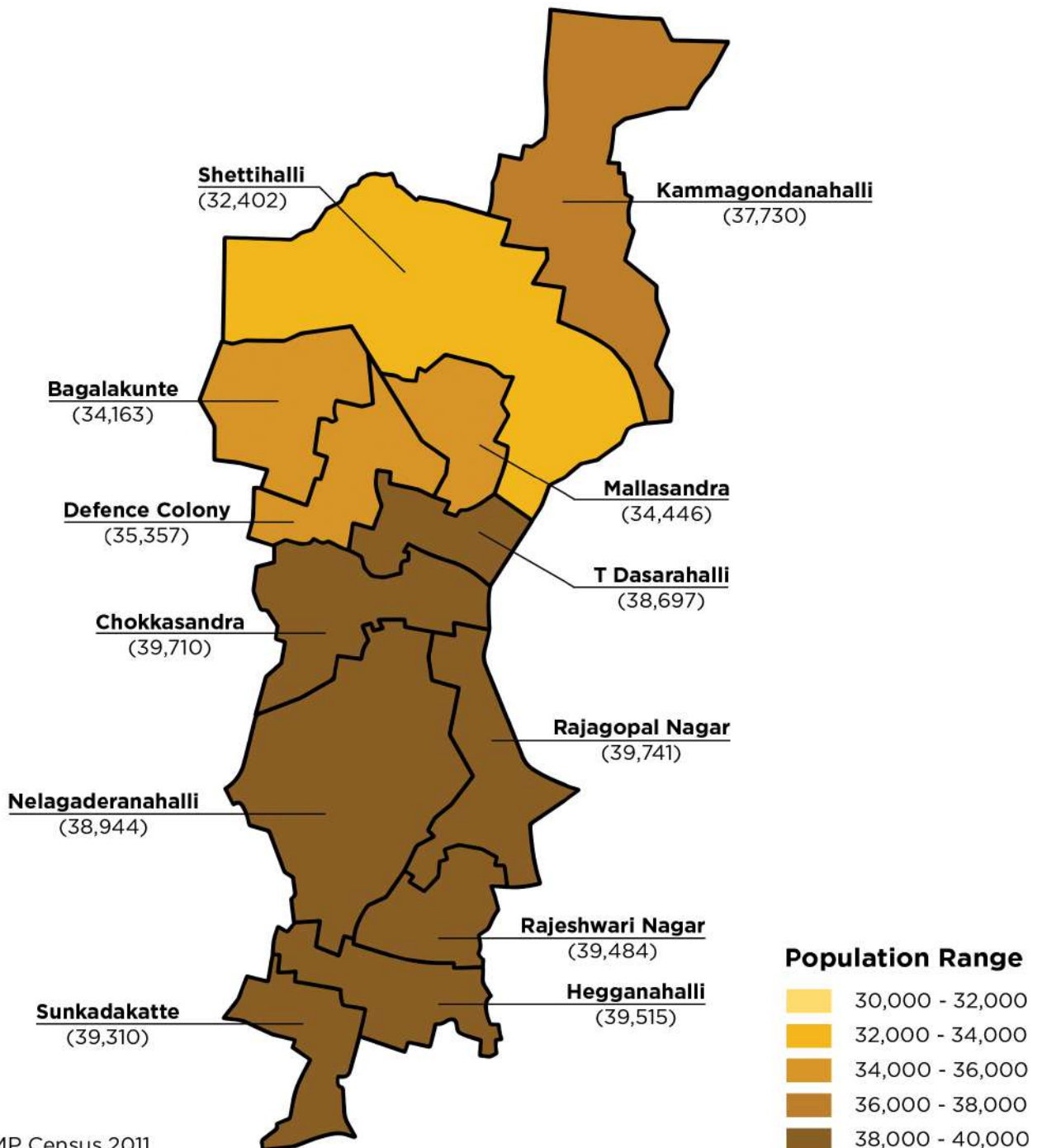

B.SAFE CONSTITUENCY - EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Dasarahalli assembly constituency is one of the 28 constituencies in Bengaluru City in Karnataka, India. The constituency is located in the northern part of Bengaluru and covers areas such as Jalahalli, T - Dasarahalli, and others

The constituency has a mix of urban and semi-urban areas with a significant population of working-class people and is known for its Industrial hubs and colleges. Namma Metro green line passes through the assembly constituency making the locality well connected. Dasarahalli has twelve municipal wards.

Audit Highlights of Public Places :

Safety audits were conducted at 10 streets based on light, openness, visibility, security, footpaths, gender usage and sense of safety.

Covering 12 municipal wards of the Dasarahalli Assembly Constituency in 6 types of public places

safety audit was conducted at 171 public places.

Key Findings :

Below are the key findings on the safety audits conducted at 6 types of public places and 10 streets in Dasarahalli assembly constituency.



Street (10)

54% of the audited streets, and the public places need to be well lit, this includes 5 streets, 36 bus stops and 14 parks.



Anganwadi (67)

Around 58% of the angwadi kendra shows the potential to expand into a full day care center as 46% of them have 20+ working mothers currently.



Bus stop (58)

41 bus stops needs to be provided with basic Facility such as seating area



Park (26)

To create a better sense of safety in the parks 24% of the parks needs to have eyes on street around the park, 77% of the parks require security guards and 96% of the parks need CCTVs



Police Station (3)

One of the police stations requires a ramp for wheelchair access.



Primary Health Care Center - PHC (6)

Three of the PHCs need separate toilets for women.



Public Toilet (11)

We suggest 7 of the public toilets need to be open throughout the day like others.

To create a better sense of safety and security, action plans on the key findings have to be implemented as to priority by stakeholders.

Summary Recommendation and Way Forward

The B.SAFE Constituency project of public place audit provides a data based approach to measure safety and infrastructure gaps to enable action by key stakeholders, thereby ensuring better safety of public places for women, children and citizens at large. It can serve as a model approach to measure public place safety for any assembly constituency.

During the study/ analysis of the sample data collected across the 12 BBMP wards in the Dasarahalli Assembly Constituency, it is observed that the overall public place safety score for the constituency can be improved by implementing the below mentioned action plan.

The top two priorities for immediate actions are :

1. Focus on fixing the street lights as almost 54% of them are poorly or unlit.
2. Bus stops become more accessible by providing basic amenities like seating, route maps and details. Improvements of walkable footpaths in and around the bus stops.

The next three priorities are :

1. Expansion of anganwadi kendras into full day care centers as 58% of them have 20+ working mothers currently.
2. To create a better sense of safety in the parks they need to have in and eyes on the street in and around the park or CCTV or security guards.
3. Opening of public toilets throughout the day and also provision of basic facilities like sanitary pads.

These changes will help Dasarahalli emerge as a model constituency on safety and empowerment.

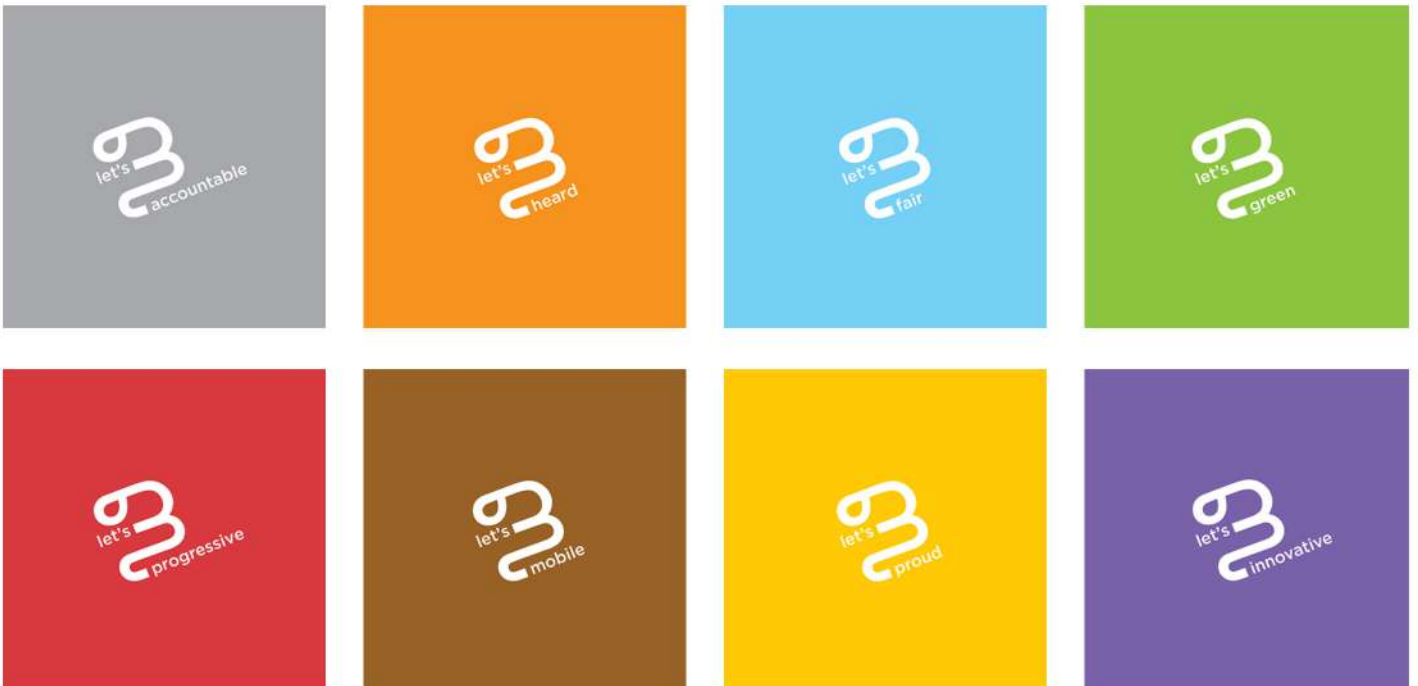
